General Terms and Conditions

1. The program is available to SavingsCentral Trade Allies who have signed a Trade Ally Participating Contractor Agreement, are BPI certified and conduct the following services listed in the document for residential customers of Central Hudson.
2. Equipment and services must be purchased after May 18, 2009 and before December 31, 2011.
3. It is the responsibility of the Trade Ally to assure that all requirements for the rebate are met and that all required documentation is provided.
4. Rebate payments will be based on the equipment purchase date and the receipt of the customer's rebate form.
5. Failure to provide any of the required information will prevent processing of your application.
6. Central Hudson reserves the right to review the installations in order to ensure compliance with all program requirements. Central Hudson may choose to review locations to verify completion of the projects and to measure and verify energy savings. Such reviews will be made at a time convenient to the applicant, with advanced notice given to the applicant. Misrepresentation of installation location or measure eligibility may result in forfeiture of the incentive award.
7. Program procedures, requirements and rebate levels are subject to change or cancellation without notice.
8. One rebate check will be issued to the Trade Ally applying for each approved and completed application per residential customer.
9. Installations must be completed in accordance with all laws, codes and other requirements applicable under federal, state and local authority.
10. You are urged to seek appropriate consultation concerning any tax liabilities that could be associated with the receipt of the rebate.
11. Central Hudson is entitled to 100% of the energy benefits associated with the rebated measures, excluding the value of energy cost savings realized by the customer.
12. The participating Trade Ally will inform and educate customers that they are ineligible to apply for incentives from any other state programs for the same equipment installation, with the exception of applying for tax credits from state and/or federal governments.
13. Central Hudson assumes no responsibility for the performance of the equipment and equipment warranty, the quality of the work, labor and/or materials supplied, and/or the acts or omissions of the Trade Ally.
14. The equipment must be purchased new and installed at the above listed location.
15. The Trade Ally hereby relieves and indemnifies Central Hudson of any and all liability associated with this project.
